MAINTENANCE WORKER

JOB SUMMARY: Performs a variety of general maintenance and repair tasks to support the safe, functional, and professional operation of Butler County Sheriff's Office buildings, facilities, structures, grounds, and equipment. Ensures facilities are maintained in good working order and present a clean, orderly appearance. Performs related duties as required.

Job duties include but are not limited to:

- Maintains BCSO buildings, facilities, structures, and equipment by performing routine and minor repairs, including but not limited to light switches, electrical fixtures, and outlets.
- Performs minor plumbing repairs; repairs broken windows; completes minor carpentry tasks; and paints buildings, offices, and structures as needed.
- Conducts routine maintenance on county equipment, including changing oil, tuning small engines, lubricating moving parts, and tightening belts and bolts.
- Conducts regular inspections of buildings and grounds to identify existing or potential maintenance issues; corrects minor problems and reports major repair needs to management or designated service providers.
- Identifies required parts and supplies to complete repairs; notifies management of needs and, upon approval, obtains parts from local suppliers.
- Prepares facilities and meeting rooms for scheduled use, including setup and breakdown as needed.
- Remains available to respond to maintenance-related emergencies and issues that arise outside of normal working hours, including evenings, weekends, and holidays.
- Performs all essential functions of the position on-site; this position is not eligible for telecommuting.
